Office Order

All the second year students of B. Sc. Agriculture Science, B. Sc. Animal Science, B. Sc. Forestry Science, B. Sc. Food Science and Technology shall be accommodated in the hostel rooms in the upper campus including the day scholars.

Students shall **not** be allowed to cook in the hostel kitchens, therefore students need not bring in ration on reporting, and also students need not go out of campus for vegetable and ration shopping once inside the campus. College shall serve food in the mess at the lower campus, for which mess contribution of Nu. 1200 /- shall be deducted from individual stipend, and self-financed students must deposit a sum of Nu. 1480 (Nu. 1200 = mess contribution, Nu. 250 = Hostel rent and Nu. 30 = welfare contribution) as soon as students report to the college.

All students shall wear face mask (reusable one) in classrooms and public gathering, at the same time follow social distancing norms, within campus gathering of **not more than three** persons shall be allowed.

On the morning of 3rd of August following activity shall take place, and classes will start from afternoon.

Office Order

A per the directives of the Royal Government of Bhutan, College of Natural Resources, Royal University of Bhutan, will reopen and called in all the second year students to allow them to complete teaching learning of some modules for B. Sc. Agriculture Science (2nd year), B. Sc. Animal Science (2nd year), B. Sc. Forestry Science (2nd year) and B. Sc. Food Science and Technology (2nd year). Conduct semester end examination and allow 30% of the class to graduate as Diploma in each field of studies by 31st August 2020.

All the students staying outside the campus as day scholars will be provided accommodation in the campus and therefore all must stay on campus.

During the period 2nd August to 31st August 2020, all the students staying on campus shall in addition to the existing hostel norms follow the following norms without fail:

1. No student shall be allowed out of campus for any reasons w.e.f 2nd August 2020
2. All the students attending classes shall wear facemask, and maintain social distancing as required by Ministry of Health
3. All students shall make use of the hand wash facilities installed at the strategic location
4. All students shall disinfect hands at the entrance of classroom using sanitisers supplied
5. No mass gathering shall take place, no gathering of 15 persons in games like basketball, volleyball, 16 persons for football in mini ground
6. Saturday afternoon shall be social work period and students shall clean hostel rooms and surrounding
