1. QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1.1. All the first-year students with preferrable prior leadership experience in previous schools
- 1.2. Possess good academic record and no disciplinary standing in the college
- 1.3. Possess in-depth knowledge of the college and its resources
- 1.4. Communicates effectively both verbally and in writing
- 1.5. Basic computer and accounting skills
- 1.6. Demonstrates sensitivity/interest in diversity/cultural differences; ability to effectively communicate with a variety of personalities
- 1.7. Function effectively in a team environment and collaboration skills
- 1.8. Have the ability to prioritize multiple tasks and responsibilities

2. RESPONSIBILITES

- 2.1. Coordinate the preparation of the annual budgeting
- 2.2. Present the proposed budget to student executive board for the adoption
- 2.3. Maintain timely financial records of the student body activities
- 2.4. Prepare financial reports at the end of every semester and report to student executive board for the endorsement
- 2.5. Coordinate fund raising projects for the student body
- 2.6. Sign and/or verifies all the purchase orders and note sheet of student body before routing through Dean of Student Affairs
- 2.7. Audit clubs' expenses in conjunction with College Integrity Club
- 2.8. Permanent member to club audit meeting
- 2.9. Assist Chief Councilor, Deputy Chief Councilors and officiate Secretary wherever deemed necessary
