1. QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1.1. Third-year students (4-years programme) and second-year student (3-years programme) with preferable prior leadership experience at CNR and previous schools
- 1.2. Should have prior experience in organizing sports events
- 1.3. Must be an active participant in college sports or games, having represented the college in any field of sports (Football, Volleyball, Basketball, and Archery)
- 1.4. Possess good academic credentials and no disciplinary standing with the college
- 1.5. Possess in-depth knowledge of the college and its resources
- 1.6. Effective communication and teamwork skills to collaborate with students, faculty, and external stakeholders
- 1.7. Basic computer skills
- 1.8. Demonstrates sensitivity/interest in diversity/cultural differences; ability to effectively communicate with a variety of personalities
- 1.9. Function effectively in a team environment and collaboration skills
- 1.10. Has the ability to prioritize multiple tasks and responsibilities

2. RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 2.1. Plan, coordinate, and execute sports events
- 2.2. Ensure proper management of sports equipment and inventory
- 2.3. Work closely with the college administration to maintain and improve sports facilities
- 2.4. Represent sports-related concerns in CETA meetings and advocate for student-athlete needs
- 2.5. Encourage student participation in sports related activities
- 2.6. Work closely with other CETA members to integrate cultural aspects into college events
